PLEASANT GROVE RECREATION

Rules and regulations for use of facilities

- 1. All applications from organizations or groups for the use of facilities shall be made on official forms provided by Pleasant Grove Recreation.
- 2. Applications may not be accepted less than ten (10) working days in advance of time facility is desired.
- 3. All requests shall be denied where the proposed use is inconsistent with the proper and regular use of facilities or where the purpose is deemed to be dangerous, illegal, immoral, or injurious.
- 4. Use of city property shall be under the supervision and control of a duly authorized representative of the Pleasant Grove Recreation Department. The organization using the facility shall follow the direction given by city representative. The organization shall enforce these rules and regulations and report any violations to the city representative.
- 5. The city representative shall open the facility upon presentation of a permit properly issued and signed.
- 6. All vehicles shall be parked in authorized spaces only. Vehicles parked illegally may be cited and/or towed at owner expense. *Private vehicles are not allowed on pathways, sidewalks, and grass areas.*
- 7. All permits shall be issued for specific facilities and for specific hours. The organization using the facility shall be responsible to see that unauthorized portions of the facility are not used or molested and that the premises are vacated as scheduled.
- 8. All juvenile organizations or groups seeking use must have adult supervision and sponsorship. A minimum of one (1) adult chaperone per twenty (20) juveniles shall be required. When security is required, costs shall be the responsibility of the organization making the application.
- 9. The organization or group using the facility shall be responsible to see that city property is protected from damage and mistreatment and that ordinary precaution for cleanliness is maintained. The organization shall be responsible for the condition in which they leave the facility. In cases where property has been damaged or abused beyond normal wear, the organization or group shall pay for the damage or abuse.
- 10. Tables may not be removed from pavilion area.
- 11. Water toys, i.e. slip and slides and inflatable water toys are not allowed on the park. Other inflatable toys (jump houses, slides without water), are allowed, stakes cannot be longer than 18" in length and generators must be kept away from surrounding residential areas. Groups will be responsible for damage caused by such toys to grass areas and sprinkler lines
- 12. No commercial, athletic, or special events will be scheduled on Sundays.
- 13. Intoxicants of any type are prohibited. Smoking is prohibited.
- 14. Gambling is prohibited.
- 15. Animals are prohibited except in Rodeo Arena (except for qualified service animals). Veterinarian required for all rodeos.
- 16. Decorations must be approved prior to installation. Decorations shall be attached to existing hardware which has been installed for this purpose. Decorations shall be removed immediately after the event.
- 17. If there is a failure to comply with any of these rules and regulations or any city ordinances by the organization applying for or using the facility or by anyone present at the event or activity sponsored by the organization or group. The city representative has the authority to stop the activity and require any or all of the participants to leave the facility and surrounding property. If any organization or individual is required to leave the facility for any violation of the city ordinance or these rules and regulations, no refunds shall be given by the city.
- 18. Commercial rentals shall have comprehensive personal liability and property damage insurance in amounts not less than \$250,000 for any one person in any single incident, \$1,000,000 for injuries to more than one person and \$100,000 for property damage. Rodeo activities have listed on the policy the name of the company that provides the stock.
- 19. Commercial rentals must have City Council approval at a scheduled city council meeting before contract and rental is complete.
- 20. Commercial rental must obtain all business licenses, permits and Pleasant Grove police security and ambulance when required.
- 21. Any deposit for buildings, rodeo arena, parks and ball field rentals is non-refundable if reservation is cancelled within 30 days of the scheduled activity.
