4on 4 Adult Co-Ed Volleyball Tournament Rules



GENERAL INFORMATION

All games are self-officiated by each team on the court. Players are on the honor system and need to make calls on their side of the court. Please be honest with your calls! Team captains are to be responsible for their team and shall settle disputes on calls. Sportsmanship is required of all players, fans, and coaches.

~~Each player must play in at least one pool play set of a match to be eligible for tournament play.~~ **NEW ** Players do not have to play in a pool play game to be eligible for bracket play... But, players must be listed on team roster by the end of their first pool play game to be eligible for tournament play.**

Team rosters must consist of at least 4 members but no more than 10 members. There must be at least 2 female players on the court at all times. Line-up:

- 2 women, 2 men or,
- 3 women, 1 man or,
- 2 women, 1 man

A full team consists of 4 players. However, a team may start and end with at least 3 players. If a team has 3 players two players will have to be female. If a team does not have the minimum number to start on the court at the scheduled game time, the team will forfeit the first game of the match. If the team is still not ready to play in ten minutes, the team will forfeit the match.

Jewelry, Hats, etc are not permitted while playing. These restrictions are for your safety.

The first server will be determined by paper/rock/scissors. The team that wins will get to serve 1st for the 1st game; the other team gets the 1st serve for the 2nd game regardless of who won the 1st game. If a 3rd game is played, paper/rock/scissors will determine who gets the serve.

SCORING

Matches will be played best 2 out of 3 games so long as time permits. The first two games are played rally score to **21 win by two, with a cap of 23**; if a third game is needed it will be played rally score to **12 win by two, with a cap of 14**.

If the match is not complete when the 40 minute time limit expires, the following will govern play:

- A. If game two is still in progress when regulation time expires, and one team has scored ten or more points the match is over and the team leading will be declared the winner. If neither team has ten or more points the game will continue to ten points. You do not have to win by 2 points.
- B. The team with the most cumulative points at the resolution of the second game (completed or to 10) will be declared the winner.

Teams shall keep score verbally. The server must announce the score before every serve. Teams are responsible for keeping an accurate score and correctly recording the game score on the score sheets provided.

Tournament Coordinators will keep the game clock for all games.

RULES & REGULATIONS

One 30 second time out per team per game can be called when the ball is dead.

If a ball is played more than once by a team, a female must make at least one of the contacts.

There are no substitution restrictions. Teams may do rotational substitution or one for one. However, if you are rotating in at a certain position, all players must rotate out... INCLUDING the setter.

Players are free to position themselves anywhere on the court. There are no positional faults. All players are considered front row the entire match (i.e. a player is still able to hit in the front row even if they just served).

Rotations for serving **MUST** stay in order—failure to do so will result in a side out.

One foot may go over the line on a serve. One reserve may be awarded if the server tosses the ball and allows it to fall to the floor.

Players may not block or attack a served ball. If a served ball hits the net and goes over it is legal to play.

Every body part is legal. Shoes must be worn at all times.

If the ball hits the ceiling on your side and comes down on your side, it is playable, if it is not the 3rd hit. If it hits on your side and comes down on the other side, it is out of bounds.
